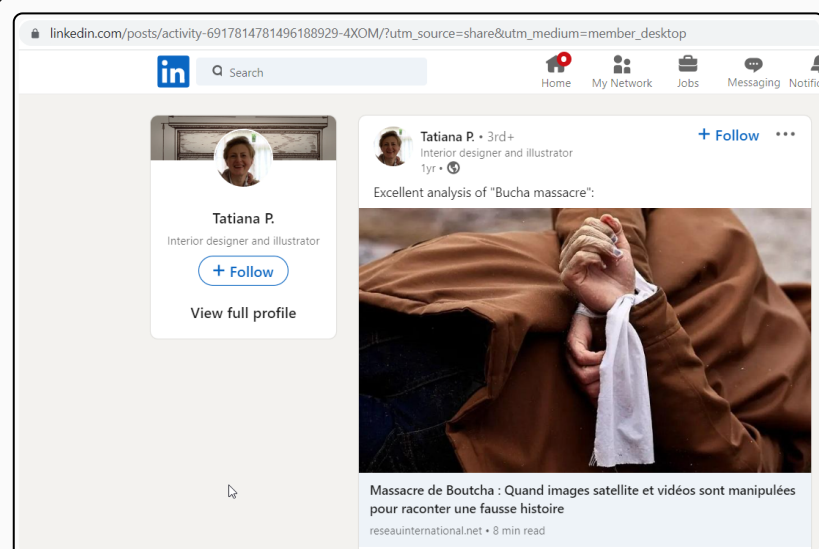

Do you know about The Alley of Angels in Donetsk? I do. In these crazy days I try to understand what happens, but unsuccessfully. "Free world fights against Russia" - Russia has to pay for those terrible crimes - you hear nothing more for the past week. And yes, Russia pays, indeed. I am not going to talk about military response and economic sanctions.

- The European Film Academy boycotted all Russian films
- The EBU excluded Russia from participating in the Eurovision Song Contest 2022 because otherwise it "would bring the competition into disrepute"
- The Royal Opera House, Vienna Philharmonic and others cut ties with Russian performers (even those who opposed the invasion of Ukraine), including world stars soprano Anna Netrebko and conductor Valery Gergiev.
- International Sports Federations do not allow the participation of Russian athletes and officials in international competitions.
- The International Paralympics Committee banned Russian para-athletes from the 2022 Winter Paralympics.
- Hermitage Amsterdam Museum has broken relationships with The State Hermitage Museum in St. Petersburg, because its director Mikhail Piotrovsky is "too close to Putin".

But sports and culture are above politics? Or these principles exclude Russia?

And, finally:

- The International Car Federation banned cats bred in Russia or owned by Russians from competitions.
- The organizer of the European Tree of the Year excluded the Turgenev's Oak from nomination.

Haven't we reached the highest point of absurdity yet? A member of Dutch parliament said in Twitter "I would rather prefer to have a windmill than a Russian in my garden". In one of untagged discussions somebody says: "EVERY Russian will pay". It seems that the whole world shows solidarity against everything connected with Russia. To be clear: I don't approve everything what happens in Ukraine now. For me, as a Russian, Ukraine is not a completely neutral.

But does everyone know the whole story? Does everyone know that the war started not on February 24th 2022, it started eight years ago, eight very long years for thousands ethnic Russians in Ukraine, humiliated, tortured and killed by the Ukrainian regime or its ally's. On the picture here is the memorial to children of Donetsk killed by bombing by their own government. UNICEF reported that at least 149 children have been killed there in 2014-2018, and it is much more by now.

What about these children? And what about children of Bosnia, Yemen, Iraq, Afghanistan? Why the whole world didn't boycott the US then with the same solidarity as it does for Russia now? Or is it another sort of violence?

Why are Russians allowed to be abused just because they are Russians? It makes me think of a black period in European history that we yearly commemorate and how to not repeat ever again...

So, we are at this point now. But what's the next?

We kindly ask law enforcement agencies to consider this publication on the site as a statement about the commission by this person of deliberate acts against the security of the world, the security of mankind and international law and order, as well as other offenses.
